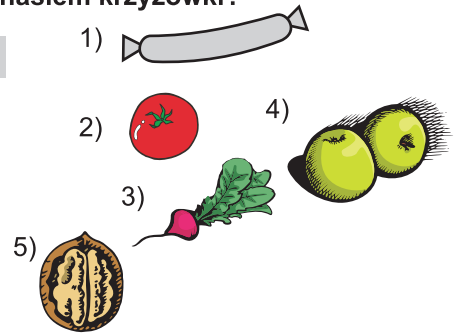
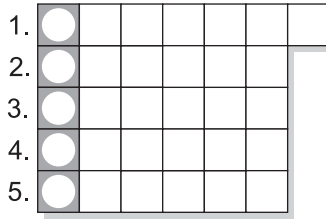

III. Reading comprehension

The Chrysler Building is a famous skyscraper in New York. It opened in May 1930. It was the tallest building in the world in that time. It is 320 metres high and has 77 floors. It is 20 metres taller than the Eiffel Tower in Paris. There are 3,862 windows and 32 lifts in the building. The lifts travel up at 213 metres a minute. The Chrysler Building is still the tallest brick building in the world.

The Empire State Building opened in May 1931 and for 42 years it was the tallest building in the world. The twin towers of the World Trade Center, which opened in 1973, were taller than the Empire State Building. But terrorists destroyed the World Trade Center on 11th September 2001, so the Empire State Building is still the tallest in New York.

The Empire State Building is 381 metres high and has 102 floors. There are 6,500 windows, which are washed twice a month, and 73 lifts. The high-speed lifts travel up at 366 metres a minute. From the 102nd floor you can see more than 125 kilometres on a clear day.

The tallest building in the USA is the Willis Tower in Chicago. It is 442 metres high and has 108 floors. But some Asian skyscrapers are much taller. The Dubai Tower will open in autumn this year. It is 818 metres high and has 160 floors.
