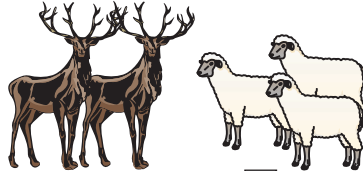

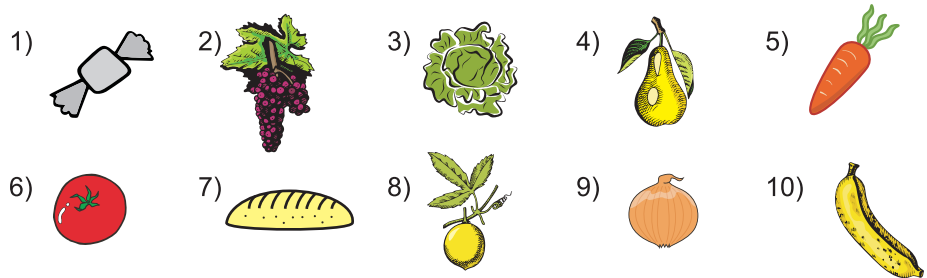
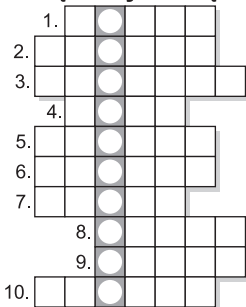

Sir Arthur Conan Doyle is famous as the writer of the Sherlock Holmes Stories. Sir Arthur was born in Edinburgh, Scotland, in 1859. He was one of ten siblings. He went to Edinburgh University and studied medicine from 1876 to 1881. While studying, he began writing short stories. He also played football as a goalkeeper. In 1882 Conan Doyle started working as a doctor in the south of England. He worked as a doctor for several years, but when he was thirty-two, he became a full-time writer. He wrote romances, adventure stories and historical novels, but it was the detective stories which made him famous. He wrote fifty stories and novels. Some of his most famous books include *The Lost World*, *The Sign of the Four*, *The Hound of Baskervilles* and *The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes*. Sherlock Holmes lived in Baker Street, London with his friend and assistant, Doctor Watson. Their enemy in many stories is a man called Moriarty. Sir Arthur was married twice and had 5 children (two daughters and three sons). He died in 1930 of heart attack.
